The Lord has given us 8 new clients! Six of the women had negative pregnancy test results, one client had a positive pregnancy test result and one came in already knowing she was pregnant. We completed 11 Learn & Earn appointments.

We are burdened for one client in particular. She is a fugitive from Honduras. She came up here with three children and 5 months ago gave birth to a baby girl. The young man she came up here with was sent back to Honduras. ICE gave her and the children paperwork so they can stay in our country for a time and work on becoming a legal citizen.

However; she is being taken advantage of from those that have a criminal past. Right now she is renting a room in a home that is close to the Access Women's Center. This man is charging her \$400.00 for one room. The landlord has a 10 year old son that is abusive to her children.

He uses a jack knife to break the lock to their room and terrorizes her children. He recently took a razor and went down the middle of the two girls scalps. The girls are ages 3 & 4. The four year old now has a deep burn on her wrist that was caused by the landlord's son. She is in the process of letting ICE know where she lives as she needs to keep in contact with them. The landlord told her she is not to give out his address. We have red flags going off for the mother and her children!
