**BEWILDERED LOVE**

No one ever loved Jesus as much as Mary Magdalene. He had done something for her that no one else could ever do, and she could never forget. Tradition tells us that Mary was a scarlet sinner whom Jesus reclaimed, forgave and purified.

It was the custom in Israel to visit the tomb of a loved one for three days after the body had been laid to rest. It was believed that for three days the spirit of the dead person hovered around the tomb, but then it departed because the body had become unrecognizable through decay. Jesus' friends could not come to the tomb on the Sabbath because to make the journey and perform the needful tasks would have broken the Sabbath traditions. But early Sunday morning, Mary came, because she could no longer stay away.

When she arrived at the tomb, she was both amazed and shocked. The stone before the sepulcher had been rolled back. The tomb was empty. Mary raced back to the city to report her findings to Peter and John. Mary is the supreme example of one who went on loving and believing even when she could not understand, and that is the love and faith which in the end finds glory.

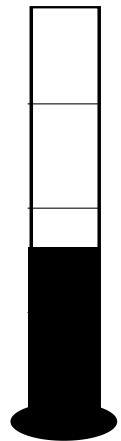
