I trust you had a blessed Christmas and our looking forward to 2020. Thank you to all who took time to send me a Christmas card, often with a letter inside. I always enjoy hearing from you! One morning in December, while having my devotions and reading God's Word, Ephesians 2:10 made me stop and think: "For we are His workmanship, created in Christ Jesus for good works, which God prepared beforehand that we should walk in them." My thought was that this verse assures me that my Heavenly Father has prepared the "good works" He has for me to do in this new year. There are ways I can serve the Lord during retirement in 2020. My clinic co-worker, Simon, called on the phone on New Year's Day. This has become an annual event. He shared that the clinic has been busy and a new midwife had been assigned to the clinic. I learned that she is the wife of our Dean of Students at West Africa Baptist College. What a blessing that is for our clinic.

Pastor David called during the holiday time as well. They would still like to dig the second well and, as I requested, he had checked on the price for such a project. The cost for digging a borehole and inserting a hand pump is approximately \$3400. It is an approximate amount because he got the quote in Ghana Cedis and we had to use the December exchange rate (cedis to dollars) to come up with the above cost. They really wanted to be able to put an electric pump on the well but, though we have the electric poles up and everything is wired, the clinic area and the village still do not have electricity. If you would be interested in contributing to this project you may send your donation to my account at Baptist Mid-Missions and indicate it is for "clinic well project". This makes sure it goes to the right place and will be used for the well project.

Please continue to pray for this medical ministry and its outreach in the Baayiri area. Pray that the clinic's Christian workers will be a testimony to the government assigned nurses. Pray that they will be able to find a Christian physician assistant for clinic. Pray also for wisdom and discernment for the national executive committee. Thank you so very much for your continued help to me and your prayers for me and for the Samuel Seidu Memorial Clinic.
